Beginning art classes in Moscow, she studied in many artists' studios through her teen years.

In 1972, A. Strogart went to Paris to study at the Ecole de Lopic. In 1974, she was accepted to the School of Art and Design in New York where she studied under the instruction of American artists, Max Ginsberg and Irwin Greenberg. During this period A. Strogart also studied at the Art Students' League in New York and apprenticed with icon painter and church restorer, V. Gordinsky.

In 1980, A. Strogart graduated from Pratt Institute, New York and later that year was elected a scholarship member of the Salmagundi Club in New York.

Exhibiting regularly at the Club, A. Strogart won numerous prizes and awards. A few years later she became a member of the National Arts Club. Lives in North Brunswick, NJ.
